Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need a business idea prior to applying for NYP Solve?

Nope! It is not necessary to have an idea when applying for NYP Solve. It is highly encouraged to have an idea in mind, however, we understand that great ideas can take time. The first 2 weeks of the Solve Program is designed to be the ideation stage for your startup.

I cannot commit for all sessions of NYP Solve, can I still apply?

Yes you can, however, your commitment to your startup will ultimately affect its quality. Solve is not a platform that exists to help you build your product, but simply guide you in the right direction.

Can I apply as an individual?

Yes, we welcome all solo founders! If you are applying as an individual but keen to look for a team, you can make use of our networking sessions after each workshop to connect with other students.

I want to join Solve and build a tech product, but I am not technical enough!

Fret not! You can still join NYP Solve and look for a team within the students that applied. Please remember that you will have to show what you bring to the table when looking for teammates too!

Must my idea be related to IT?

No it does not, you can apply with a startup idea not related to the IT sector! Do note that we may not be able to support you directly in certain areas we are not specialized in, however, we will do our best to connect you with an industry mentor.

I am currently on my internship/FYP, can I still apply?

Yes, you can apply. However, we will be unable to issue any SOA or letters to excuse our programs. Any time spent on Solve will be at your own discretion.
